Modifications have been made to the original bid packet release. If you plan to send a response, a new copy of the bid packet must be downloaded before submitting.

1. Just to make you aware that the bid date stated on the RFP as due on March 20 and opened on March 21st, could the County please issue an addendum to state the correct bid date for the documents for when the RFP is due, we understand it to be due April 3rd at 2PM and opened on April 4th? **In order to allow respondent 30 days to complete and submit a bid packet, the due date has been corrected.**

2. Could the site visit requirement be removed for Com-Tec from the RFP as we are familiar with the site conditions? See page 5 paragraph 1.3.2 of the RFP.

EXCEPTIONS: In the event a bidder desires to take exception to any term or condition set forth in the Sample Agreement, and/or any of its Exhibits and Attachments, said exceptions must be clearly identified in the response to this Request for Bid. Exceptions or deviations to any of the terms and conditions must not be added to the Request for Bid pages but must be a separate document accompanying the bid.

Should the County omit anything from this bid request which is necessary to provide a clear understanding of the work, or should it appear that various instructions are in conflict, then the bidder shall secure written instructions from the Purchasing Department at least forty-eight (48) hours prior to the time and date of the bid opening shown on page one (1).

3. Does the required equipment need to be installed by the proposer or should we to provide installation as an option? See page 5 paragraph 1.3.1 of the RFP. **This information has been added to the updated to the price sheet.**

4. Should we provide an anticipated project completion date within our proposal? **This Information has been added to the updated bid packet.**

5. Do we need to provide a bid bond for this RFP and a performance and payment bond if our bid is accepted? **To be considered a legal bid, a bid bond is required. Once the service is satisfactorily completed, the bid bond is returned.**
