
**ORDER**

1. That the procedure for soliciting bids was properly followed as outlined in Statute ACA 14-22-101 et seq.
2. That the lowest and most responsible bid was submitted by Com-Tec Security, in the amount of Thirty Five Thousand, Four Hundred and Thirty Four Dollars (\$35,434.00) should be approved.
