
ORDER

Now on this 5 day of June, 2017 comes on for consideration the matter of the awarding of the proposal for the Historic Courthouse HVAC for Buildings & Grounds, and from various bids submitted, and other things, matters and proof before the Court, the Court finds:

1. That the procedure for soliciting bids was properly followed as outlined in Statute ACA 14-22-101 et seq.
2. That the lowest and most responsible bid was submitted by Multi-Craft Contractors of Springdale, AR, in the amount of Seventy Eight Thousand Two Hundred Forty Six Dollars and Twenty Seven Cents. (\$78,246.27) should be approved.
3. That bidder agrees to meet all specifications as outline in RFP #2017-05
