The Policy Shall Include the Following Coverage:

In consideration of the premium detailed below, with respect to insured locations in the United States, its territories and possessions and Puerto Rico, this policy is extended to insure Certified Act(s) of Terrorism. All other terms, conditions and exclusions of this policy including applicable limits and deductibles remain unchanged and apply in full force and effect to the coverage provided by this policy.

Any loss or damage and resulting business interruption for which the Company is not responsible under the terms of the Terrorism Risk Insurance Act, as amended (all hereinafter, "TRIA"), are not insured under any circumstance by this coverage extension regardless whether caused by or resulting from an insured peril.

Disclosure of U.S. Government Participation in Payment of Terrorism Loss

The United States Government, Department of the Treasury, will pay a share of terrorism losses insured under the federal program. The federal share equals (see table below) of that portion of the amount of such insured losses that exceeds the Company's applicable retention. However, if aggregate insured losses attributable to terrorist acts certified under TRIA exceed \$100 billion in a calendar year, the Treasury shall not make any payment for any portion of the amount of such losses that exceeds \$100 billion.

Dear Judge Wood:

It is again that time of year for us to send out your vehicle and property schedules for review in preparation for the budget process and the upcoming 2019 renewal.

Please review the vehicle schedule enclosed to make certain all vehicles are listed. You should also review the values for those vehicles with physical damage coverage and adjust where necessary to show the *current value* as some of the vehicle values may still show the purchase price. Please remember when reviewing and adjusting values to include radio equipment or any other equipment that may be attached or installed in or on the vehicle. Also keep in mind it is not necessary to show a value if you only want liability protection. The current auto liability limits are the state required minimum limits of \$25/50/25. CSL (combined single liability limits) of \$100,000 are available. Please contact our office if you are interested in a quote for this optional coverage.

We are also enclosing your current property schedule for review. As the building and contents protection is for replacement coverage, please review these values and adjust where necessary to show replacement cost. The coverage for heavy equipment is ACV (actual cash value) so these values should be adjusted accordingly. Please take the time to review the location address and make sure we have the 911 location address for each location. The occupancy, construction type, year built and square footage information should also be checked for accuracy and filled in if this information is currently blank.

Please note changes to the schedule and return to our office by Monday, September 17, 2018. This will allow us time to prepare endorsements and make any updates prior to the calculations for budget and renewal.

Finally, we are enclosing a copy of a flyer that outlines the additional services offered to RMF members. If you are not taking advantage of these services and you are interested, please contact me for additional information.

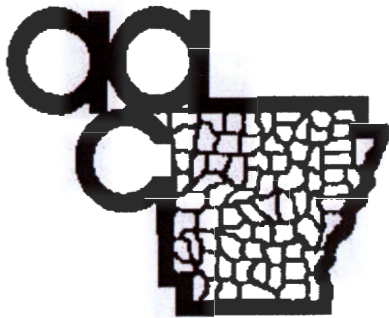
