BID 2025-02 Drug Testing Service

1. Who is the current provider of services? **Courthouse Concepts**
2. What is the current price the County is paying for collection services? **\$1,872.50**
3. Would the County be open to utilizing an admit form for positives or send directly to the laboratory?  
**They do use admit forms**
4. What Instant Drug test is being utilized? (Example: 14-panel dip, 14-panel TCup, iCup) **16-Panel**
5. Will the collectors be expected to enter all results into the laboratory system? (example: Sentry, ToxAccess or Aversys) **No**
6. If the collectors do not enter the results into the laboratory system how will the County receive the results? **No, they document on paper. Probation enters**
7. In RFP 2024-05 Drug Testing Service (from last year) the volume was listed as 350 tests a week and four testing days. Why was the testing reduced by half? **Not enough money for 4 days a week.**
8. What has the actual testing volume been for the last 8 testing days? **Courthouse closed so no testing, but between 60-80 every day**
9. What is the breakdown (numbers) female to male donors? **Dependent on the day, but more male**
10. What is going well with the current collection provider? **Everything**
11. What would the County like to see improved with a new provider? **Nothing**
12. Why did the County opt to not extend the current contract into a multi – year contract? **Rebid required**

13. At the Washington County Courthouse will the collectors have access to dedicated bathrooms, a workspace for a computer and supplies necessary to complete collections? **Yes Dedicated Bathrooms**
14. What happens if the collection time goes over 2 hours? **They finish up people who can go and show up before 10. Can send to probation**
15. You mention 175 test collected per week, is that split evenly each week? **That's just an approximation**
16. What % is female and male? **More male than female, differs**
17. Will we be able to charge for 175 people if you go under this number? **Just approximation**
18. How often is 175 people per week tested last yr out of 52 weeks? **They were testing 4 days a week plus weekend day so can't answer**
