

## NEW RULES FOR PRIMARY ELECTION

### REPUBLICAN BALLOT STYLE

A rule change for the Primary Election only allows a Registered Democrat two ballot style options: Democratic or Nonpartisan

Registered Democrats will need to complete a new Voter Registration Form to receive a Republican Ballot

No legislative changes were made for the deadline to change party affiliation during an Election.

This allows a Registered Democrat to change their party affiliation during the Voting process to receive the ballot of their choice.

*Voters who are registered as Optional (left blank on form), Republican, Nonpartisan, Independent, Green or Libertarian will not need to complete a new Voter Registration Form for any ballot style selected*
